

CLASSROOM RULES

HATTIESBURG HIGH SCHOOL BAND 2007-08

Members of the Band are expected to:

1. Be in the band hall, in their assigned seat, ready to play the first note by the time that the tardy bell rings (7:30AM) with their instrument, equipment, music, pencil and accessories. Individually warm-up, tune-up, purchase accessories and prepare for the rehearsal ahead of time (7:20AM or earlier).
2. Leave their backpack/bookbag near the cubbies outside of the band set-up.
3. Have no prohibited items (cellphone, mp3 player, games, etc.). If found, they will be confiscated.
4. Remain in their seat the entire class period unless they have permission to get up.
5. Leave gum, food, and drinks outside the band hall.
6. Show respect for others; keep hands, feet, objects, and unkind remarks to themselves.
7. Follow directions the first time they are given. Raise their hand for permission from the instructor to speak.
8. Show respect for the podium. No talking or playing out of turn. (no comments & no "noodleing")
9. Use acceptable language. Profanity will not be tolerated and will be an automatic office referral.
10. Respect the property of the school and of others. Do not touch or play instruments or use equipment that does not belong to you or that is not checked out to you. This includes percussion instruments.
11. Allow teachers to teach and classmates to learn.
12. Go to the restroom and get water between class periods.
13. Be excused at the end of the class time by the instructor and store music, instruments and equipment in their proper places.

Automatic Detentions:

1. Gum, food, or drinks in the band hall.
2. No instrument (or accessories required to play it) or refusal to participate. (Student's grade will also be severely affected)
